February 2008 Scholarships

1-CAVS/FIRST MERIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

High school seniors who intend to pursue a post-high school education are eligible to apply. Requirements include a maximum 500 word essay on "What's the most important lesson you've learned up to this point in your life and how do you plan to apply that lesson going forward?", transcript, SAT/ACT scores and 1 letter of recommendation from a high school faculty member.

DEADLINE: Noon, FEBRUARY 7

2-BURGER KING SCHOLARS PROGRAM

These \$1000 awards may be used for educational expenses during the first year of college or post-secondary vocational/technical school. Selection criteria include a minimum 2.5 gpa, work part time at least 15 hours a week, demonstrate financial need, and participate in community service or co-curricular activities. Applications are available online at www.bk.com/scholars.

DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 13

3-BEST BUY SCHOLARSHIPS

Graduating seniors with a minimum cumulative high school gpa of 2.5, who demonstrate commitment to and involvement in volunteer community service or work experience, and plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school in the United States this fall are encouraged to apply. Fifteen hundred students nationwide will receive \$1500 and an additional fifty-one \$10,000 awards will awarded.

4-OACRAO LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Six \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who plan to attend an **OHIO** college/university next fall. Requirements include a minimum gpa of 2.75, a personal statement, leaderships & service activities, one recommendation from a high school teacher/counselor and one recommendation from a community member who can address your leadership/service activities.

DEADLINE: Noon, FEBRUARY 22

5-CHAGRIN VALLEY WOMAN'S CLUB

Selection criteria for these \$1000 awards include financial need, academic achievement, community involvement, and work experience. A transcript, 2 teacher recommendations, a photo, and an interview are required.

6-CHAGRIN FALLS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

CHAGRIN FALLS BOOSTER CLUB

The 2 organizations listed above will be awarding a number of scholarships to graduating CFHS seniors at the May 17th Honors Banquet. All seniors are encouraged to apply. To streamline the application process, they have a web-based common scholarship application. Selection factors vary for each organization. The evaluation process considers the student's entire high school career and requires an interview. **Please note that some applicants may not be selected for an interview.** ♦Please see the signature page of the application for further information regarding interview dates and times. Also, please be aware that the organizations do not communicate with each other regarding selections. Therefore, a student can receive a scholarship from each of the above organizations. It also requires a copy of IRS 1040 and the FAFSA. **DEADLINE: NOON-MARCH 3**

The Chagrin Falls Historical Society scholarship criteria include academic record, work experience, extracurricular and community service activities. Three short essays are required. An interview may also be part of the process. **DEADLINE: NOON-MARCH 10**

The Gauga County Panhellenic Association will award seven \$1000 scholarships to graduating **FEMALES** who are **residents of GEAUGA County** and plan to attend a 4-year college in the fall. Selection criteria include an essay, a transcript, activities, and community service. **DEADLINE: NOON- MARCH 12**

13-CHAGRIN FALLS EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

CFEA will award a \$500 scholarship to a senior who is planning to pursue a career in education. Selection criteria include activities, references and an essay. **DEADLINE: NOON-MARCH 14**

Three \$1000 awards will be made to graduating seniors of Lebanese or Syrian descent with a B or better average. Criteria include transcript w/test scores, 2 recommendations, and an essay. **DEADLINE: NOON-MARCH 19**

Other requirements include a college letter of acceptance, transcript, essay, and 2 teacher recommendations.
